

## Tournament Rules of “Plumilla Fishing” or Bucktail jigs, Pesca, Playa y Ambiente, Inc.

- Every vessel and / or tournament participant must comply with the safety measures required by the Office of Navigation of the DRNA.
- They should have the security equipment up to date.
- Categories- The first 2 x each category will be awarded.
- Special prizes for the biggest Capture (Measured, photographed and released) and Extra Capture a.
- Kayaks / SUP Youth Boats-15 years or less.
- Youth, Ladies, Adults, Fly.
- Official Line of the Tournament and Strength Capacity: OPEN line that is not metallic (Monofilament or Braid) or contains some metallic material (lead core braid) up to 16lb of force.
- Use of leader: The use of monofilament leader is allowed only. Metallic leader or that contains some metallic material will not to be allowed.
- Type of lure accepted: It will be accepted as what is known as “Plumilla” or buck tail and any type of hook with lead head and tail of rubber or combination of both. Any other type of bait other than those mentioned above are PROHIBITED.
- Tournament officials may request the review of the equipment to be used, may also request the double-line review, leader, hook, bait, etc.,
- The use of two or more hooks in the same bait will not be allowed.
- The use of any type of natural bait is not allowed, neither does chumming or “engoe” to attract fish.
- Trolling or any Act recognized as fishing during a boat is in motion created by the engine will not be allowed.
- Eligibility measures per piece caught: Size of each piece in general is 12 inches (except species with specific measures or the law imposes a measure greater than the tournament) All pieces are measured from the mouth to the fork of the tail. These measures will be evaluated by the judges appointed by Fishing, Beach and Environment. Inc.
- **All participants must have the langler Tournament Application on their phone and be enrolled in the Fishing, Beach and Environment tournament.**
- **All captures must be photographed and entered in real time, at the langler Tournament application.**
- All species shall be measured and photographed, 1 pt x every inch shall be granted, except for Permits and Bonefish that are worth double.
- Species with specific measures and that may be addressed at the discretion of the fisherman: Macarela or Mackerel 16 inches (by law no more than 5 per person or 10 per boat) or Sierra or Kingfish 20 inches (by law no more than 5 per person or 10 per boat) or Snappers or Pargos- According to the DRNA Regulation. Colirrubia or Yellowtail

Snapper- greater than 10.5 (fork length) as established in the Fishing Regulations of the DRNA.

- Catch, Photo & Release Species: If one of these species is approached and killed, the boat will be automatically eliminated from this tournament and may be banned from future PPA Tournament.
- Any type of Tuna, including Bonitos or Jureles (Jacks) or Vastago or Robalo (Snooks) or Sharks or Sábalo (Tarpons, prohibited by law), if it is greater than 30% u201D, must be photographed in the water. Boarding prohibited. o Permit- (prohibited its capture by DRNA Fishing Regulations. o Bonefish- Prohibited its capture by DRNA Fishing Regulations. o Barracuda or Candil or Medregal or Black Horse Mackerel or Manta Raya (any type) or Mero Batata or Jewfish (prohibited capture by law ) o Mero Cherna (capture prohibited by law)
- Any species whose capture is prohibited by law.
- Fishing schedule: Departure at 7:00 AM and all vessels must be back at 3:00 PM at the Club Náutico de La Parguera.
- In case of doubt or question regarding catches, you should contact Control by VHF (designated channel) cell phone. In case of an emergency must immediately notify control.
- Maximum of fishermen: 4 fishermen per boat.
- Age youth category: All young people 15 years old or younger.
- Substitutions of fishermen: Must be done before 7:00 AM to Control
