Below you will find the itinerary and additional details you will want to know about so **please read thoroughly.**

Boats have assigned numbers. Please make sure you know your boat number as times of departure vary each day based on it. Each boat will have three anglers, however the team you are fishing with to try to win the Grand Slam trophy and bragging rights is done via a random draw thru iAngler which will be shown on the TV's at the rooftop bar Wednesday evening. This means your boat mates are technically your competition...be nice to them anyway. We are fishing for snook, red and trout.

Two Day Itinerary

Wednesday, April 21

10:00am Registration begins in the Private Dining Room (back room off Castile restaurant)

Please check spreadsheet to find out what your team/boat number is as this will determine what time you depart and return each day.

NOTE: Kris Becker will be collecting for side action - \$20.00 per angler that wants to participate. Payout will be based on amount collected.

Please make sure you have iAngler downloaded to your phone as various raffles will happen throughout the day and announcements of how to win them will be pushed through the iAngler app.

11:30am designated team captain should collect the captains gift bag, lunch and drinks for boat for all anglers and boat captain.

11:45am all angler meeting – pool deck

12:00-12:10 teams 1-12 depart marina and return between 4:30-4:40pm

12:00-12:10 teams 13-24 depart marina and return between 4:40-4:50pm

12:20-12:30 teams 25-35 depart marina and return between 4:50-5:00pm

6:30pm Cocktail/Dinner Reception – 360 Rooftop Bar, Zamora Hotel.

Team assignments will be posted for anglers to seek out their teammates and strategize on how to win the Grand Slam.

8:30-8:40 teams 25-35 depart marina and return between 4:30-4:40pm

8:40-8:50 teams 1-12 depart marina and return between 4:40-4:50pm

8:50-9:00 teams 13-24 depart marina and return between 4:50-5:00pm

Boat captains remember to tip your captain. Recommend a minimum of at least \$100 per boat for the two days.

7:00pm Awards Dinner – 360 Rooftop Bar, Zamora Hotel

Awards will be given for:

- First Place Grand Slam (random team draw) - total inches Red, Snook & Trout
